





INSTALLATION CONDITIONS

Install the module in the following environment.

- ·Cover the working area with a conductive or antistatic mat.
- •This mat must be safely grounded with a resistor (1 M Ω \pm 20%).
- •The surrounding air temperature must be between 0°C and 55°C.
- •Ambient humidity must be 90% RH or less (with no condensation).
- •No extreme changes in temperature that can cause condensation
- •Free from corrosive or flammable gases
- •Free from dust, salts, or iron dust
- •Not subject to water, oil, or chemicals
- •No vibration and/or shock directly transmitted to the product



1. Remove the module cover (K) by pressing in the cover near the hooks and sliding the cover.




Installing the Board

3. Hold both ends of the board (A) and firmly insert the board connector into the connector port on the **SERVOPACK** connector firmly into the connector port. A-Board




Mounting the Module Cover

7. Secure the module cover to the SERVOPACK by pressing in the cover near the hooks and sliding the cover.


